Annual Meeting Logo Application

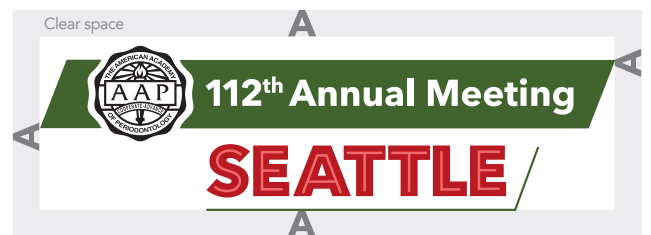
Appearance on backgrounds

The only background that the Annual Meeting logo can appear on is the clean section of an image, white/clear, or a solid color from the color palette. Please refrain from using any other color or distracting imagery.



Clearance space

The clear space for the logo is determined by the height of the cap 'A' in 'Annual' in the logo. Keep all text and distracting graphic elements outside of this clear space.

Typography

The fonts chosen for the 2026 Annual Meeting are clean, contemporary, and easy to read. This should ensure that all materials are created with a clear visual hierarchy and are reader friendly.

Fritz Quadrata Medium should be used for headline copy and can also be used as specialty body copy.

Avenir font family should be used for body copy.

Avenir Condensed family can be used as an alternate body copy when space is limited, or to create differentiation in places where multiple hierarchal levels are needed, such as schedules.

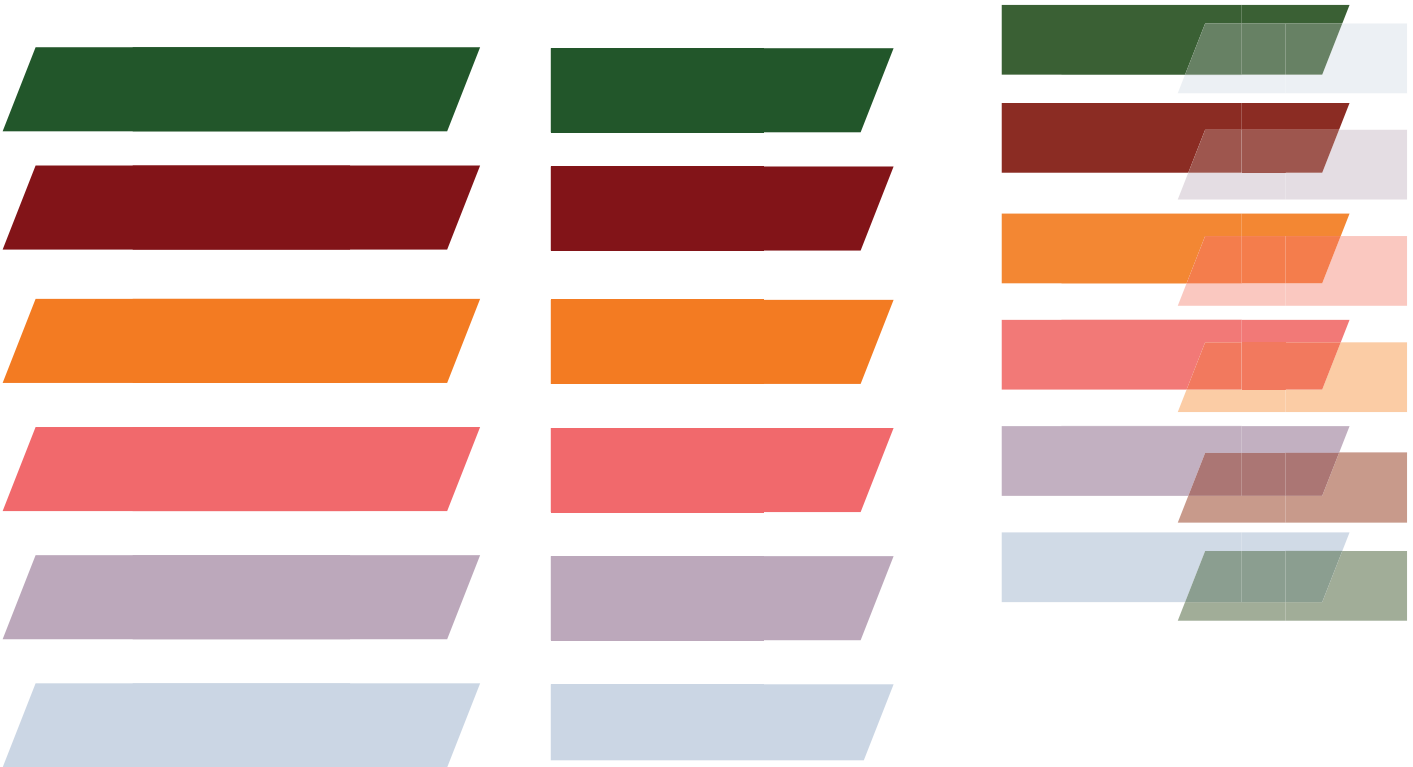

Design Elements

Angled shapes

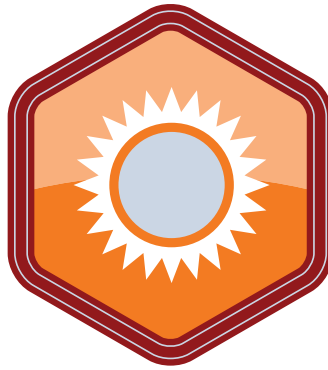
The angled shape in the logo and the color palette are the main design cues for the 2026 Annual Meeting. The shapes make for good page headers and footers, and can be incorporated within a page layout for added design interest. If creating a quadrilateral, the angle should be as close to 21.5 degrees as possible. The meeting colors and opacities can be varied for interest.

Wall Paper

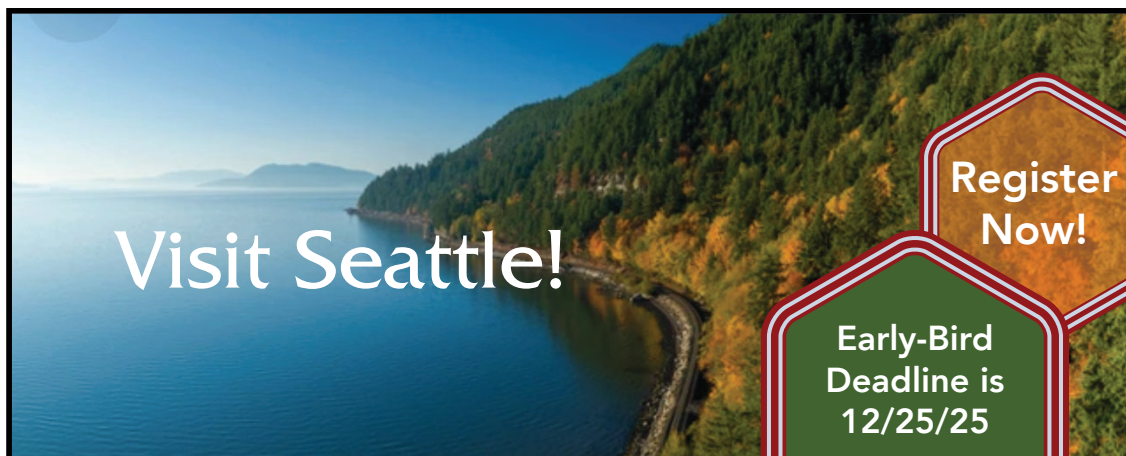
Badges can be used in a step and repeat pattern to cover large areas.
